# **Transportation to Lamont Campus**

### To/From The Time, Nyack

The Time, Nyack will provide shuttle service to and from the conference. Capacity of the shuttle is 14 passengers and will make two trips in the morning and evening. The departure/return times of the shuttle are:

- Wednesday, June 8:
  - o Departure from The Time Nyack: 7:30am, second shuttle departing upon return
  - O Departure from the IRI (Monell Building): 7:30 pm, second shuttle departing upon return
- Thursday, June 9:
  - Departure from The Time Nyack: 7:30am, second shuttle departing upon return
  - Departure from the IRI (Monell Building): 6:30pm, second shuttle departing upon return
- Friday, June 10:
  - Departure from The Time Nyack: 7:30am, second shuttle departing upon return
  - o Departure from the IRI (Monell Building): 1:15pm, second shuttle departing upon return

### **To/From Columbia University Morningside**

There will be one shuttle departing from Columbia University's Morningside campus and returning in the evening. The shuttle will depart from Amsterdam Avenue between 116th Street and 117th Street. It will drop off and pick-up in the evenings in front of the IRI (Monell Building). The departure/return times of the shuttle are:

  - Departure from from IRI (Monell Building): 7:45pm (following the evening reception)
- Thursday, June 9:
  - o Departure from Morningside: 7:30am
  - Departure from Comer Building: 6:30pm (following the poster session)

  - Departure from Morningside: 7:30am
  - Departure from IRI (Monell Building): 1:15pm
